How to Apply for Under Graduate Admission into our college through Samarth Admission Portal

Steps to Apply

1. Register on the SAMARTH Portal

Website: <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>

- **Procedure:**
 - Click on “New Registration”.
 - Enter your full name, date of birth, mobile number, email ID, and create a password.
 - Complete the CAPTCHA verification and submit.
 - An OTP will be sent to your mobile number; enter it to verify.
 - After successful registration, note down your registration number for future use.

2. Complete Candidate Profile

- **Login:** Use your registration number or email ID and password to log in.
- **Profile Details:**
 - Fill in personal information, contact details, and educational history.
 - Upload required documents such as:
 - Recent passport-size photograph
 - Signature
 - ID proof (e.g., Aadhaar card)
 - Domicile proof of Assam
 - Class 10th and 12th mark sheets and certificates
 - Caste certificate (if applicable)
 - Disability certificate (if applicable)
 - Gap certificate (if applicable)
 - Ensure all documents are in JPG or JPEG format and between 10 KB to 500 KB in size.

3. Select Programmes and Colleges

- **Programme Selection:**
 - Choose the university (i.e., Gauhati University).
 - Select college as “Kaliabor College” to study at our college.
 - Choose the programme type:
 - NEP-Scheme (stream-based courses, i.e. B.A./ B.Sc./ B.Com.)
Subjects to be selected based on 1 Major 1 Minor or 2 Minor Scheme
 - NEP-Discipline (discipline-specific courses, i.e. BBA/BCA/BVoc/Biotech)
 - Specify your preferred major/minor subjects (for NEP-Scheme only).

4. Submit and Lock Your Application

- **Review:** Double-check all entered information and uploaded documents.
- **Declaration:** Agree to the declaration terms.
- **Lock Profile:** Once satisfied, click on “Lock Profile” to finalize your application.

5. Check Merit List and Proceed to Admission

- Wait for publication of the merit list
- If selected, follow college-specific instructions for offline admission

Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) Course

This is an undergraduate programme under the FYUGP structure of the Gauhati University implemented from the academic session 2023-24 as per UGC's Curricular Framework published in November 2022, based on NEP 2020. The programme is classified in two structures. The Bachelor's degree programme shall be of six semesters and the Bachelor degree with Honours programme is of eight semesters (for degree with Honours) consisting of Core Courses along with Common Courses like SEC, MDC, VAC and AEC. A student needs to earn a required number of credits in order to successfully complete a degree. For Admission into the Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) Program under Gauhati University, candidates are required to choose a scheme of study from the following options:

- A. 1 Major 1 Minor (for Major)

Selection must be made at the time of application through the SAMARTH portal.

- **Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.)**

Major Subjects: Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics, Zoology, Economics

Minor Subjects: Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics, Zoology, Economics

For Admission into the Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) Program under Gauhati University, candidates are required to choose a scheme of study from the following options:

- A. 1 Major 1 Minor (for Major)
- B. 2 Minors (for Minor)

Selection must be made at the time of application through the SAMARTH portal.

Eligibility: A student who has passed the H.S. (10+2) in Arts, Science or Commerce from the AHSEC or an equivalent examination with at least 45% in aggregate may apply. Students appearing in the 10+2 final examination, whose results have not yet been declared may also apply.

Admission Procedure:

Admission shall be made on the basis of the marks obtained in H. S. (10+2) Examination. The selection of Major will be on the basis of merit on the day of admission, subject to the availability of seats.

Requirement of Attendance: A student shall have to attend minimum 75% of total classes in each paper to be eligible to appear in each semester end examination.

Post Graduate Courses

These are two year (four semesters) full-time programme leading to the master degree of Gauhati University in both Arts & Commerce streams are -

Eligibility: Candidates need to have a bachelor's degree with a minimum of 50% marks.

Admission Procedure: From the academic session 2019-20, all PG admissions of Gauhati University including those in its affiliated Colleges will be conducted through a Common Entrance Test to be organised by the Gauhati University. Students seeking admission into PG courses shall have to fill-up online application Form in the Gauhati University portal. Students desirous of admission into NEF College will have to opt for this College at the time of Counselling.

Requirement of Attendance: A student shall have to attend minimum 75% of total classes in each paper to be eligible to appear in each semester end examination.
