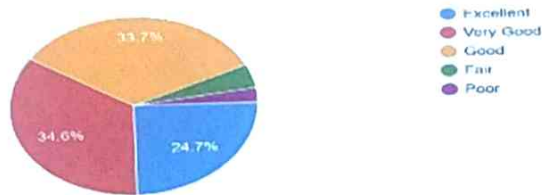


Feedback Analysis 2023-24

1. How fair is the selection criteria of admission in the institute?

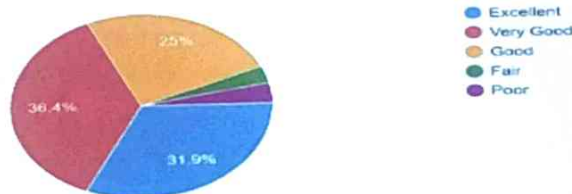
1. How fair is the selection criteria of admission in the institute?

2. How well are the teachers able to communicate?

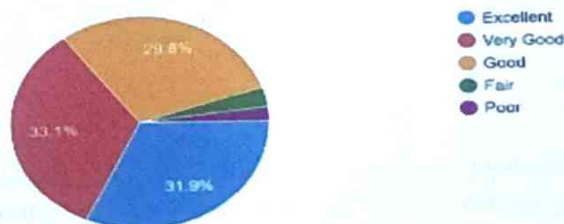

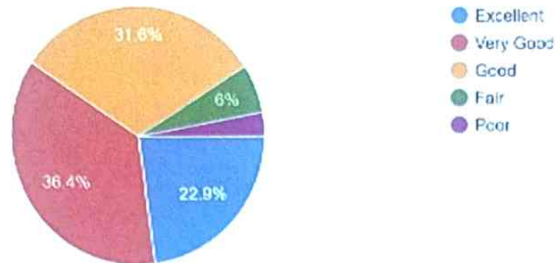


The teachers teaching approach has been rated mostly *excellent*, *very good* and *good* category by Kaliabor college students.

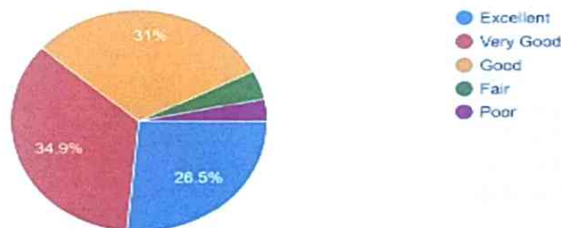


In the internal evaluation process 36.7% has rated for very good and 31.6% has rated for good category by Kaliabor college students. Whereas 3% has rated as poor for this process.

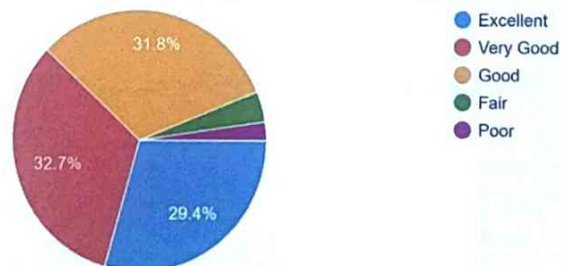


Most of the student's (i.e. 34.9%) has rated very good to teachers in encouraging students to participate in different co-curricular activities.

6. How do you rate the punctuality of the teacher?

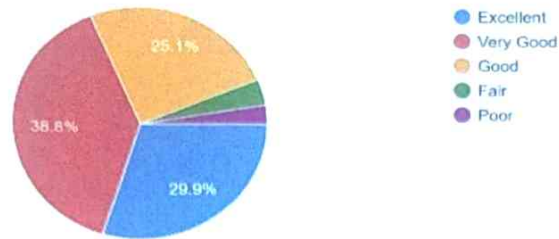

The commitment to being on time not only sets a positive example for students but also creates a structured and efficient learning environment. In Kaliabor College teacher's punctuality in class taking 32.5%, 32.2% and 29.3% students have rated as good, very good & excellent respectively.

7. How do you rate the communication skills of the teacher?

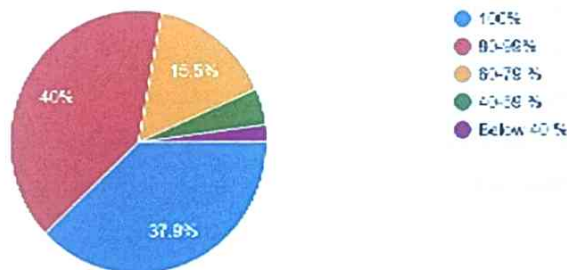
7. How do you rate the communication skills of the teacher?

In 2023-24 feedback 38.5% students have rated teachers as very good, and 29.6% & 25.7% have rated as excellent and good respectively to teacher's communication skill.

8. How much the syllabus was covered by the teacher?

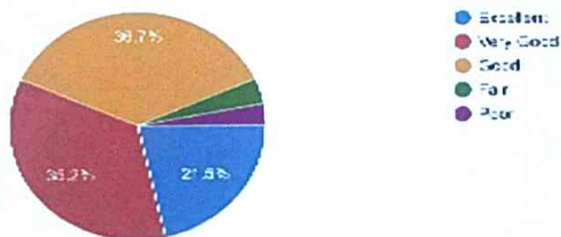
8. How much the syllabus was covered by the teacher?

10. Does the teacher use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. while teaching?



In teacher's ICT application at classroom teaching-learning process 35.7% and 29.5% students have rated as good and very good, while 17.1% and 11.5% have expressed as excellent and poor category.
