Date: August 27-September 27, 2023

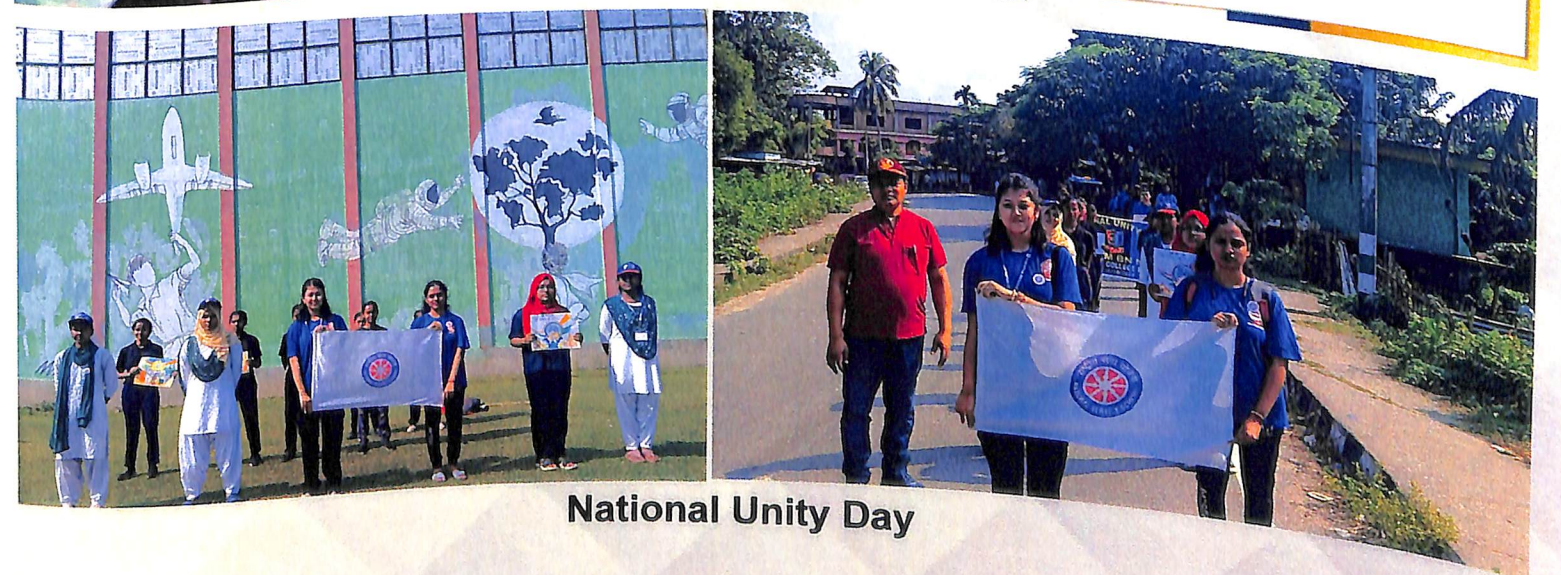
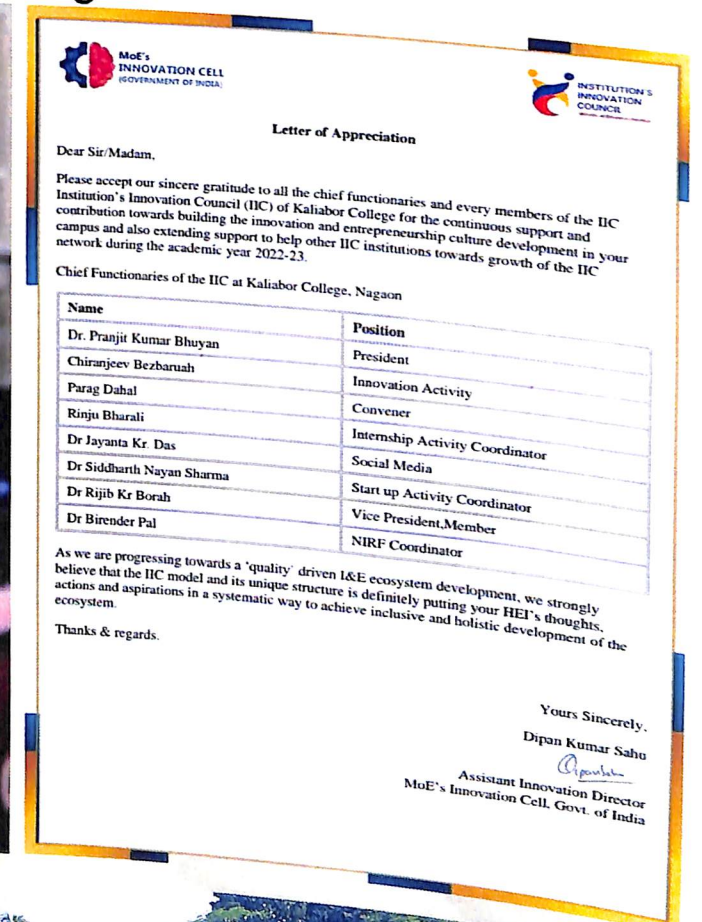

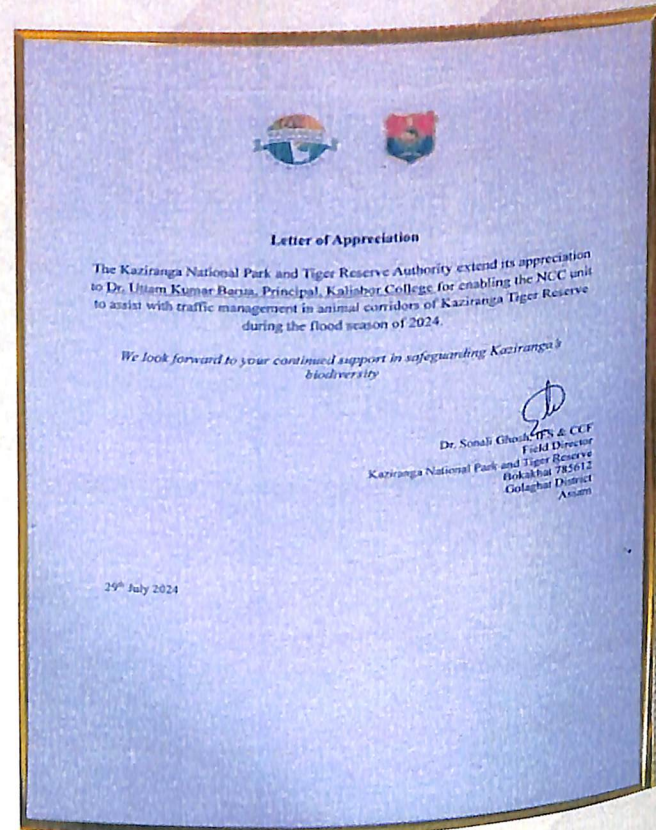
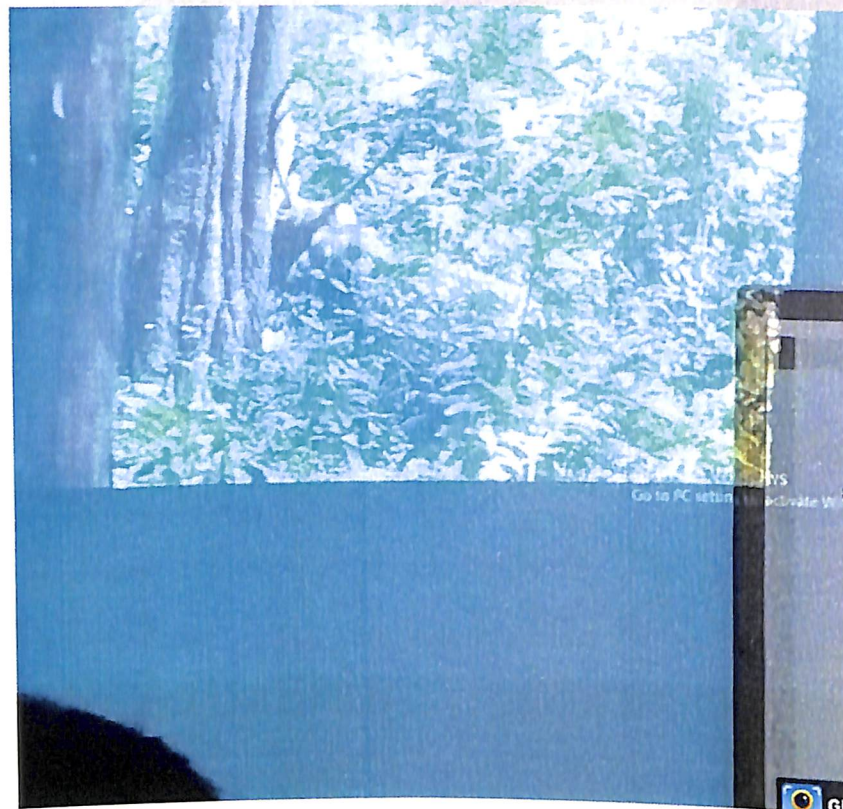
Popular & Motivational Talk on Biodiversity Conservation and a Journey from Depression to Inspiration

Date: September 24, 2023

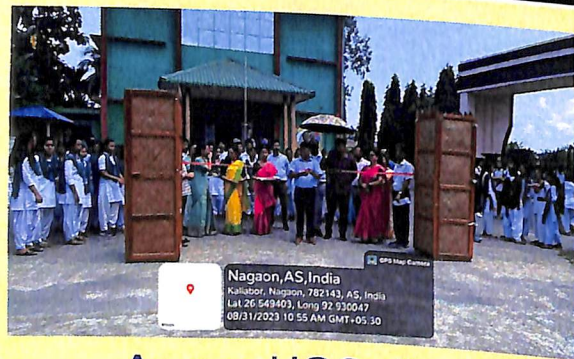
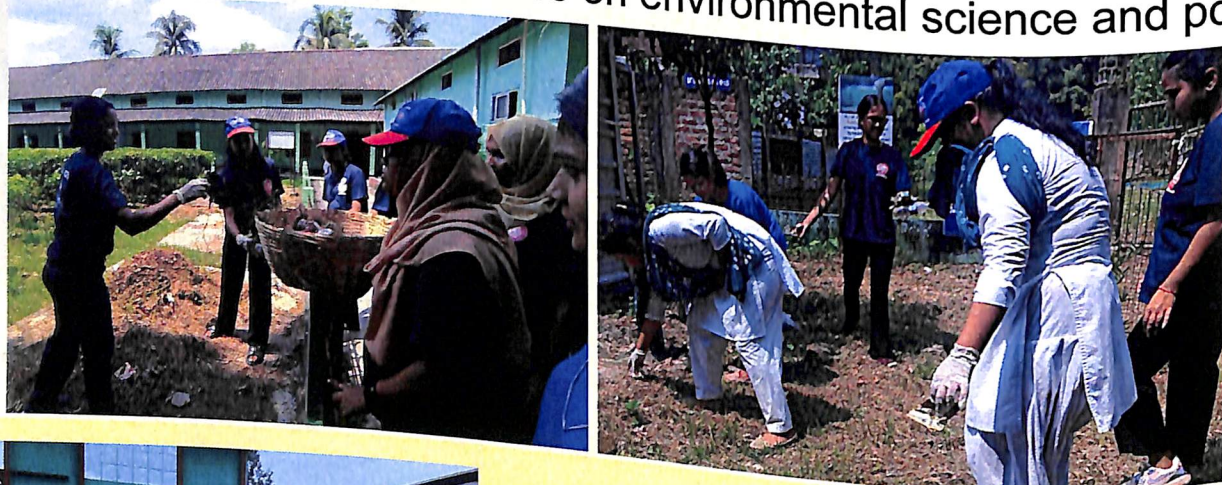




Swachh Bharat Mission Extension Activity

Date: November 10-11, 2023

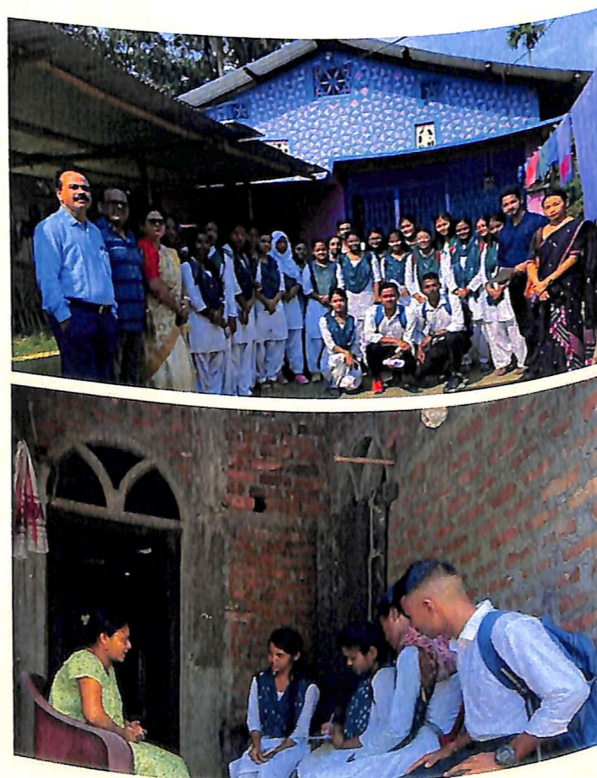

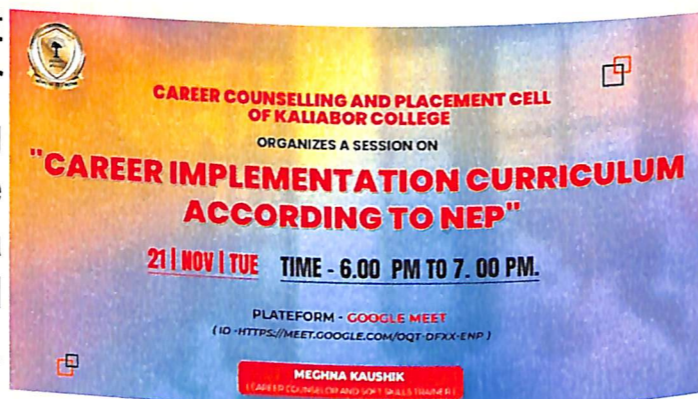


Dr. Barnali Sarma led a field visit for BSc Biotechnology students to an Apiculture farm on November 4, 2023.

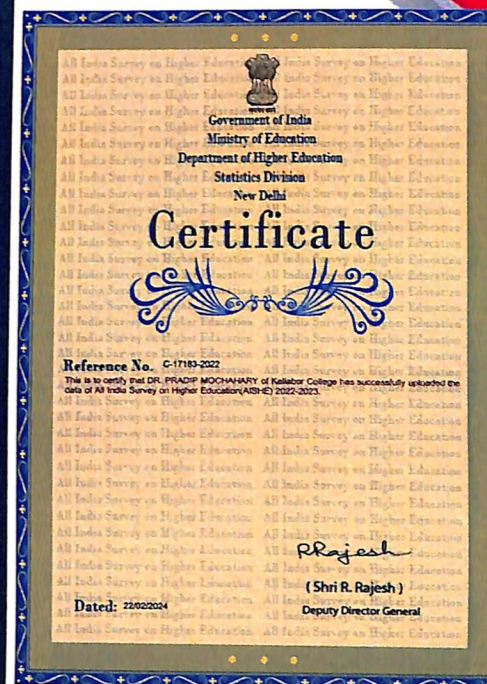

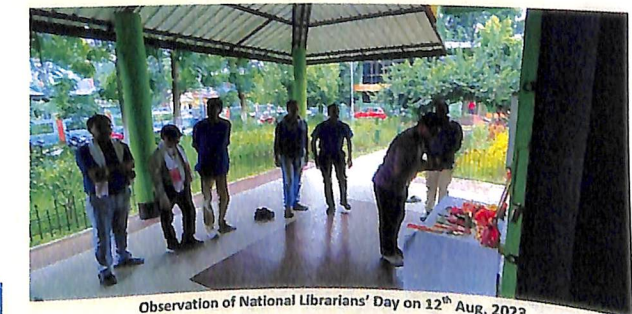

Date: May 3, 2024

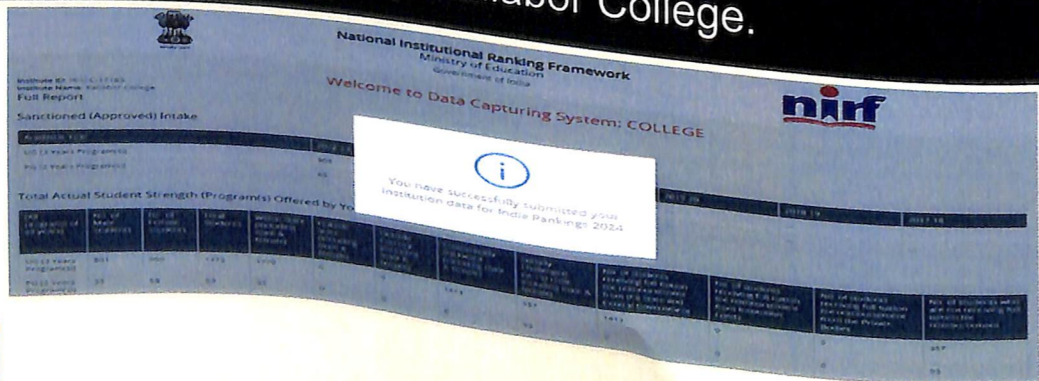
On May 3rd, 2024, students of the B. Voc Department organized an educational field trip to Balipara Miri

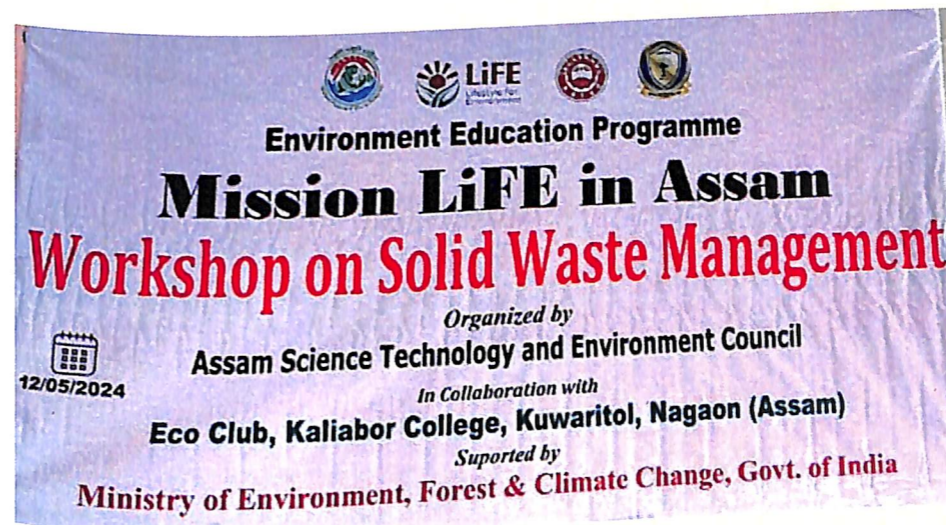


Eco Club Workshops :

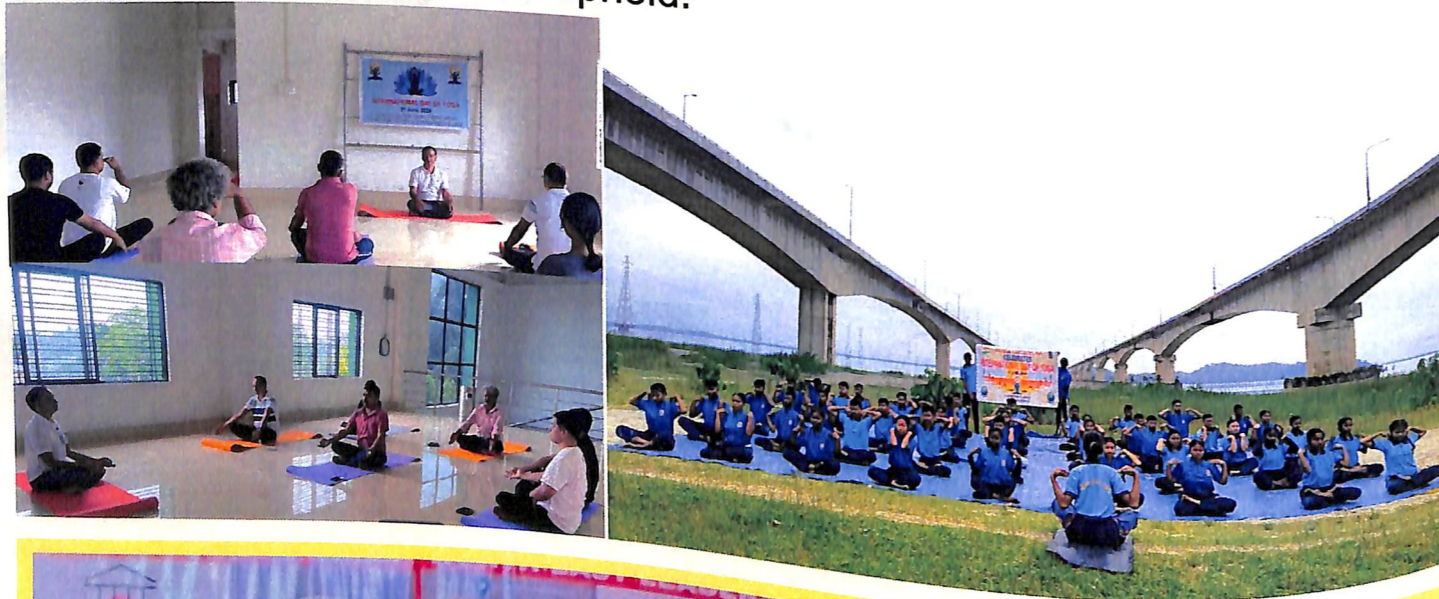


Kaliabor College Observes International Day of Yoga

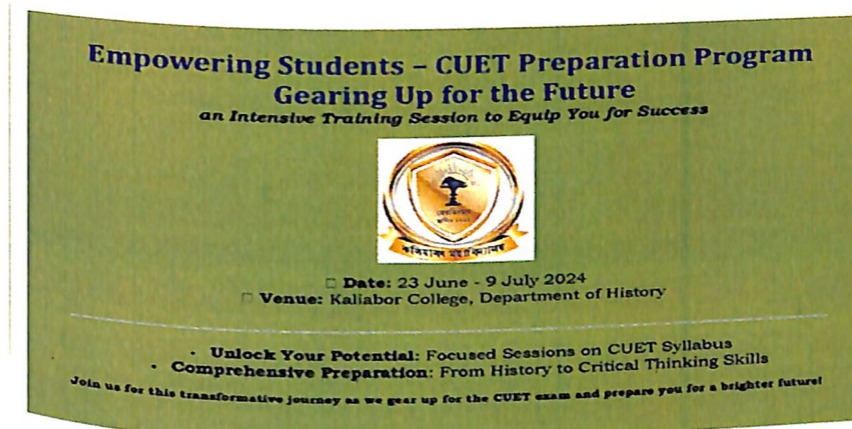

Date: June 23-July 9, 2024

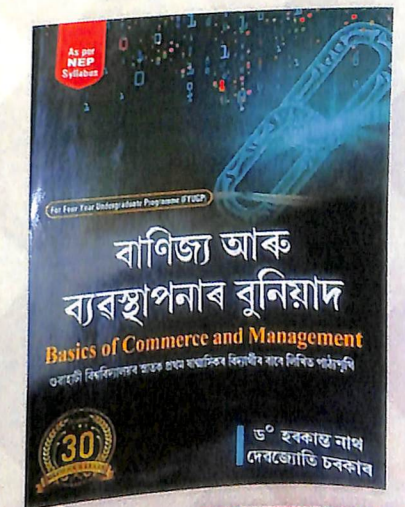
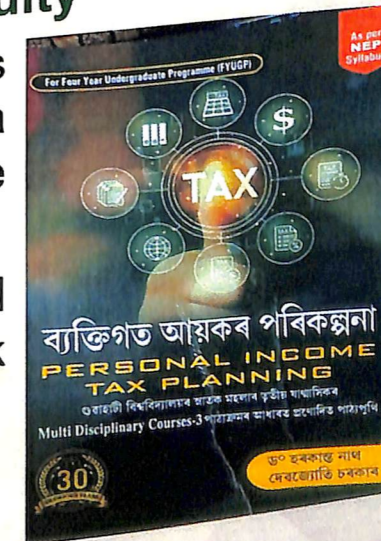
